How Did We Do?

In Quarter 4, 206 Clients completed the OR2 Program.

Who Did We Serve?

- The average age of OR2 Clients was 47, ranging from 20 to 70 years old
- The most common industry was Trades/Construction/Transportation (42.6%), followed by Health (23%), Sales & Service (10.8%) and Processing/Manufacturing/Utilities (10.8%)
- OR2 Clients participated in an average of 36 clinic days
- The most common type of injury seen was Sprains/Strains/Tears (80.4%), followed by Fracture (10.3%)
- The most common Injury Area treated was Shoulder (26.5%), followed by Lumbar Spine/Sacrum (20.6%) and Multiple Areas (14.2%)

How Satisfied and Included Did They Feel?

- 94.1% was the overall Client satisfaction score
- 94.1% of Clients would recommend Back in Motion to a friend
- 96.3% of Clients felt that the facilities were easy to access
- 93.1% of Clients felt prepared for the services received
- 94.1% of Clients felt included in the services received

How Did We Help?

- 92.6% of Clients were fit to return to work upon program completion
- 46.1% were working at program end with:
 - 74.5 % of those working full-time in the pre-accident job, or working in modified duties (such as reduced or altered hours) or in a new job; and
 - 20.2% were still on a GRTW
